1. RULES

- 1.1. The regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS) **including the Australian Sailing Special regulations Part 2.**
- 1.2. **Appendix S - Standard Sailing Instructions and** Appendix T – Arbitration will apply

2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. Entries will be accepted from Pacer, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Sabre, Optimist, Minnow, 420 & 29er Class Boats and Windsurfer
- 3.2. Competitors must be female members of a YA affiliated club.
- 3.3. Competitors must wear the provided Regatta Bibs at all times when on the water.

- 3.5. The closing date for entries is Friday 17th February 2017, 5pm.

4. FEES

- 4.1. The Entry fee for each competitor is \$150.00 weekend, \$95 day entry.
- 4.2. Entries received after 5pm, Wednesday 8th February 2017 will be charged an entry fee of \$165.00 (weekend) / \$110.00 (day)

5. FORMAT

Boats will compete in short 20-25 minute races.

6. SCORING

Each boats series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score once 4 races are completed and excluding her worst 2 scores once 8 races have been completed.
