Commodore Andrew Plympton (AP) welcomed all members to the 68th Annual General Meeting.

AP noted that 1 member had been awarded Queens Birthday Honours and congratulated John

Bertrand.

AP informed members of the layout of the Polling Booths and how each section would be asked to

vote due to the space restrictions.

AP noted an apology from Warick Leeming and thanked him for his efforts over the last 2 years.

AP said that the order of events will be changed and the Election of Officers will now be Item 2.

1. Minutes from Previous Meeting

4. Election of Officers and Ordinary Members of the Committee

AP said as this is the first time for a contested election of a significant appointment, there has been a determination regarding how to hold the ballot. It is to be a secret ballot. The Secretary Phillip

PW said there are simple objectives - to obtain accurate results and that all eligible members record a vote that is legible and able to be counted. PW introduced Ralph Wilson and Peter Hannah as

Election Managers and Peter Osbourne is the Independent Club Scrutineer. PW explained the

different cards & operational eligible criteria. The ballot paper and 'show of hands' options, along

with the polling booth options.

Murray Homes said that he has received advice regarding the constitution; and that the outcome of

the election could be put in doubt. AP outlined the legal advice from Hunt & Hunt regarding the 2013 Amendment of Rules that has been lodged. Written evidence to be given to M Homes, but the

election is being conducted to the rules of the Constitution.

AP handed the meeting to Secretary PW to conduct the ballot for Commodore.

At the end of the voting process PW asked the meeting if there were any eligible voters in the room

that had not yet voted. Scrutineer PO concurred that all eligible voters the room had voted.

The meeting resumed after voting was completed.

AP provided letter from Dept. of Justice 8/7/2013 to candidate Mr Homes confirming that the Rules

of the Club had been accepted.

The Commodore announced that, "as the number of nominations for the remaining General

Committee are equal to the number of vacancies, it is not necessary to conduct a ballot, and the new

committee are elected in the respective positions." They were introduced to the members.
