1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 Off the Beach Boats.
- 1.2. Appendix S: Standard Sailing Instruction and Appendix T; Arbitration will apply
- 1.3. Changes to rules that will be detailed in full in the sailing instructions include:
 - Outside help to recover a crew overboard or separated and return them to their boat with no advantage will be allowed.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Boats may be entered by members of their class Association by agreeing to the [conditions of entry](#), paying the entry fee and completing the entry form, which contains other conditions and an alert about the risks of sailing which the person entering the boat, must agree to [ENTER HERE](#)

3. FEES

- 3.1. The entry fee is \$65 per boat entered by noon Thursday 17/10/2019
- 3.2. An additional \$30 late entry fee will apply to each boat entered after noon Thursday 17/10/2019
- 3.3. Entry closes at 10:00 am Saturday 19/10/2019

4. SCHEDULE and FORMAT

- 4.1. Racing will be conducted in sessions, 6-7 short races per day are planned depending upon weather conditions and forecast.
- 4.2. Presentations will be held each day after racing.

- 6.1. Boats shall hold a valid measurement certificate and sails shall have been measured.
- 6.2. Boats may be inspected for compliance with Safety Regulations and Class Rules at any time.

8. RACE AREA and COURSES

- 8.1. Triangle and Windward / leeward courses will be laid off the club.

- 12.1. Each boat shall be insured with third party liability insurance of at least \$5,000,000 per incident.

Neither the Organizing Authority nor its in conjunction partners will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
