Spectator Ferry

For those who wish to follow the event rather than sail, the classic 1939 ferry "Proclaim" has been chartered by the Club. The ferry will depart from Mosman Wharf at 12.15 pm, and then depart from Old Cremorne Wharf at 12.30. The ferry will return at approximately 3.00 pm.

Food and refreshments will be available on board, and there will be a commentary by Bill Gale on the fascinating story behind many of the yachts.

Tickets are \$65.00, and include the ferry trip, finger food and a welcoming drink. Continuing drinks will be available on board with a cash bar.
