### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including AS Special Regulations Part 1 Cat 7
- 1.2. Appendix S – Standard Sailing Instructions and Appendix T - Arbitration shall apply

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to Jubilees of members of an Australian Jubilee Yacht Association.
- 2.2. All boats shall be entered and skippered by a current financial member of a District of the ILCA

- 3.1. \$150 per boat Early Bird entry or \$200 per boat if entered after 31st December 2017

- 7.1. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score once 5 races are completed, 4 Races are required to constitute a series.

### 8. PRIZES

The Huntingfield Cup shall be awarded to the winner of the Australian Championship.  
 The Les Pound Trophy shall be awarded to the first Victorian boat.  
 The Victorian JYA Trophy shall be awarded to the first New South Wales Boat  
 The Charles Peel Trophy shall be awarded to the winner of the final race.  
 The highest place boat helmed by a female shall be awarded a trophy.  
 Individual trophies may be awarded to each boat placing first second and third in the Championship.  
 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee.

### 9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 9.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. Neither the Organizing Authority nor it's in conjunction partners will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

- 10.1. All boats are required to hold at least \$5m Pubic liability Insurance for the racing.
