Saturday 9th and Sunday 10thJune 2018 SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



1. REGATTA OFFICE, NOTICE BOARD, FLAG POLE LOCATION & CHANGES TO SIS

- The Regatta Office and Notice Board is at the Northeast corner of the club on the lower level and the flagpole is East of the Regatta Office.
- RRS S3 is replaced with. Amendments to the SI made ashore will be posted at least 1 hour before the start of any race affected or before AP/H is removed. Amendments made afloat will be signalled by the display of flag L with 1 sound signal. The Race Committee may communicate these either verbally or in writing.
- Add to RRS 41: (e) help in navigation and trim, or to recover from a capsize, from an authorised race official that is given to a junior or novice sailor that is struggling to stay with the fleet.
- AP over a numeral pennant 1-9 is deleted from Race Signals.

2. SIGN ON – SIGN OFF

Boats shall sign on before going afloat and sign off at the first reasonable opportunity upon returning ashore (at Regatta Office) [DP]

3. FIRST WARNING SIGNALS

Saturday 9th June1200Sunday 10th June1100

4. TIME LIMITS

Target Time20-25 minsRace time limit45minsFinishing window10minsBoats not finishing in the finish window may be allocateda score. Changes RRS 35, A4, A5 & S12.3

5. THE FINISH

The orange flag in RRS S11 is changed to a Blue flag.

6. INFLATABLE MARKS

Start PinBlack and white*Finish PinBlue1, 2, 3See Division for colours*If a Black and white flag mark is laid near the start line,4.7s shall leave it to Starboard and other lasers shallleave it to port

7. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

When the AP flag is displayed ashore, 60 mins is replaced with 30 mins. This changes RRS S4.2.

8. THE START – Changes to RRS 26

- The warning signal shall be 3 mins before the Starting signal
- The preparatory signal shall be 2 mins before the starting signal.
- If a class flag is half /semi –displayed, it is not displayed for the purposes of RRS 26 and it indicates the next class to go into sequence.
- After the starting signal the RC may abandon a race instead of general recalling and send that class to a later start order.
- When the Big Fluoro Green flag is displayed, Dinghies shall keep completely away from the start line, approaches and area used for Couta Boats starting. [DP]
- Note Couta boats will be using a 5-minute sequence

9. PENALTIES

- RRS 44.1 and 44.2 is changed so that a One-Turn penalty applies to Foilers, Skiffs and Cats
- The Post-Race Penalty in RRS T1 (b) is changed to 25% of the difference between the boat's finishing score and the score for RET rounded up to the nearest whole number. Penalties for breaches of rule other than a rule of Part 2 or RRS 31 are Discretionary [DP]
- For each division, the protest time limit and redress time limit is 45 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day. "or two hours after the incident, whichever is later" is deleted from RRS 62.2 and changes \$13.2



10. DIVISIONS – Class Flags and Marks 1,2, & 3 Colour will be as follows
