



# NOTICE OF RACE

## WOW Sorrento Coaching Regatta

### Saturday 3<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2018

The Organising Authority is Sorrento Sailing Couta Boat Club

Volunteer Development will be delivered during the boat coaching sessions.

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing including the Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2.
- 1.2. Appendix S - Standard Sailing Instructions and Appendix T – Arbitration will apply

#### 2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. Eligible classes 420, 29er, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Sabre, Optimist, and Team Racing in supplied Pacers until that class' quota is filled.
- 3.2. Each class has a minimum and maximum allocation.  
Classes that do not meet the minimum entries will have their allocation moved to another class and competitors will be refunded their entry.
- 3.3. Competitors must be female members of an AS affiliated club.
- 3.4. Entry is via <https://sscbc.com.au/WOW18>
- 3.5. Late entry fee and cancelling of classes not meeting minimum numbers will apply from Wed 14/2/18
- 3.6. The closing date for entries is Fri 23/2/18, 5pm.

#### 4. FEES

- 4.1. The Entry fee for single-handed boats is \$125.00 and \$250 for double-handed.
- 4.2. Entries received after 5pm, Wed 14/2/18 will be charged an extra \$15 per competitor

#### 5. FORMAT

Dinghies will compete in short 20-25 minute races.

#### 6. TEAM RACING

6 boats will be supplied for the Team Racing Division. Competitors may enter as a single competitor or team of 2 competitors. Appendix D Team Racing will apply. Format random pairs / 2v2 /3v3 etc will be described in SIs.

#### 7. SCORING

Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score once 4 races are completed and excluding her worst 2 scores once 8 races have been completed. One race is required to constitute a series.
