2018 Victorian & Open 420 and '9er Championships - Appendices P, S & T apply

1. REGATTA OFFICE & FLAGPOLE

N/E corner of Club. Flagpole to N/E

2. RULES

- 2.1. For the 9er classes the two-turns penalty in RRS 44.1 and P2.1 is replaced with a one turn-turn penalty.
- 2.2. RRS P2.3 is deleted and RRS P2.2 shall also apply to subsequent penalties.
- 2.3. When AP is displayed ashore, RRS S4.2 is changed to "not less than 30 minutes"
- 2.4. RRS S3.1 is deleted, any change to the sailing instructions will be posted 90 minutes before the first scheduled race it effects.
- 2.5. The Post-Race Penalty in RRS T1(b) is changed to 25% of the difference between a boat's score and RET score.

3. SIGN ON – SIGN OFF

Boats shall sign on before going afloat and sign off at the first reasonable opportunity upon returning ashore (at Regatta Office) [DP]

5. CLASS FLAGS

420	Blue insignia on White Flag
29er	Red insignia on White Flag
49er/49erFX	Dark Blue on Pale Blue Flag

6. THE START

RRS S9.2 is changed to: The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on a race committee vessel at each end.

7. THE FINISH

The orange flag in RRS S11 is changed to a blue flag.

8. TIME LIMITS

Target Time	30 min
Race Time limit	60 min
Finishing Window	10 min

Boats not finishing within the Finishing Window may be allocated a score [DP] This changes RRS 35, A4, A5 & S12.3

9. COURSES

The courses, diagrams and signals referred to in RRS S7 in Appendix S are replaced with those on the next page.

10. INFLATABLE MARKS

11. SUPPORT PERSONS

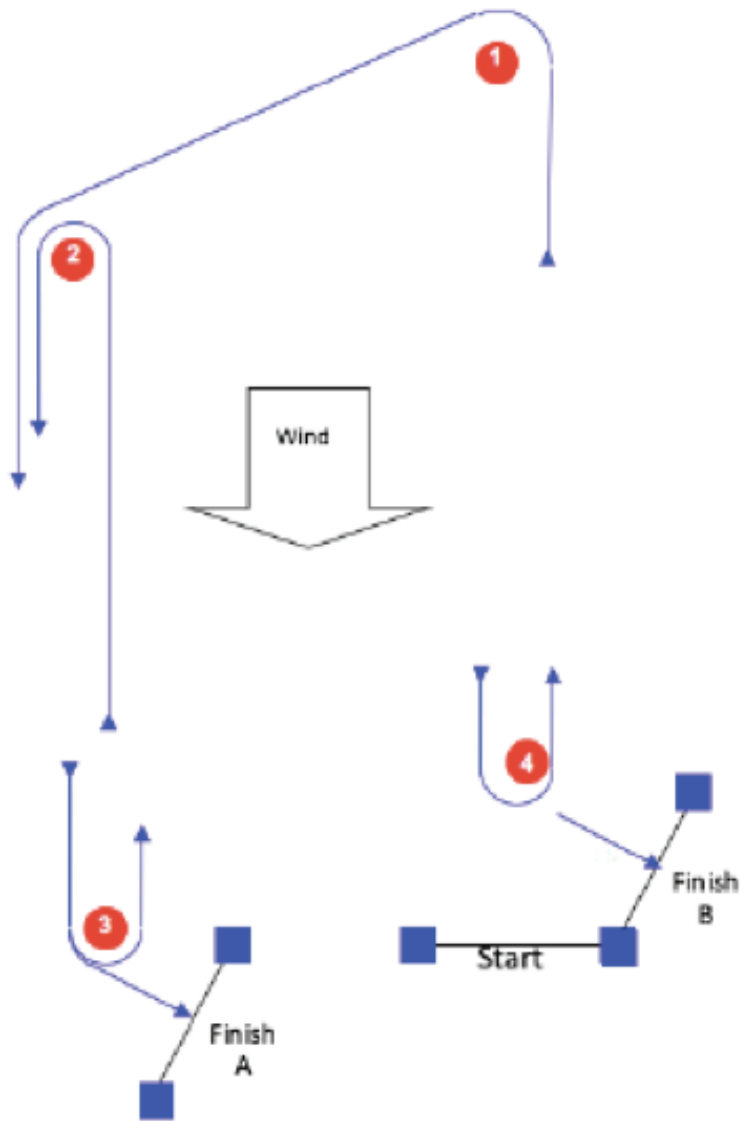
Support Persons shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first class to start until all boats have finished or retired or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment. [DP]

12. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION [DP]

- 12.1. Requirements for equipment inspection will be posted on the ONB.
- 12.2. Penalties for breaches of Class Rules are at the discretion of the Protest Committee.
- 12.3. 29er boats are reminded of the new class rule C3.1 (b) Whistles

13. 49er SPINNAKERS

- 13.1. The NOR has been amended so that only new type spinnakers may be used on 49ers to ensure a level playing field.
