1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including AS Special Regulations Part 2
- 1.2. Appendix S – Standard Sailing Instructions and Appendix T - Arbitration shall apply
- 1.3. The Supplementary Sailing Instructions will change rules 44.1 and 44.2 - Penalties

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to International B14 Class boats entered by members of their National Authority and Country B14 Association

3. FEES

- 3.1. \$350 per boat Early Bird entry or \$430 per boat if entered after 30th November 2018
This includes 2 Tickets to the Welcome and Presentation functions, additional tickets \$60

10 Races are planned, no more than 4 races shall be sailed on a day. The Lay Day may be changed due to weather.

6. VENUE

7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1. All boats shall be presented for measurement in accordance with the above schedule.
- 7.2. Equipment checks and inspections may be carried out at any time. A boat notified of inspection shall follow the instructions of the Technical Committee

8. SCORING

- 8.1. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score once 5 races are completed, and 2 worst scores when 8 races are completed.
- 8.2. 4 Races are required to constitute a series.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

- 9.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

10. PRIZES

- 10.1. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, placed boats for scratch and handicap (Australian Residents)
- 10.2. Open Championship winner
- 10.3. Additional prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the B14 Association of Australia

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. Neither the Organizing Authority nor it's in conjunction partners will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

- 12.1. All boats are required to hold at least \$5m Pubic liability Insurance for the racing.
