### Courses

#### On the Wind Start SI 15 and Fixed Finish (BOX) (Pursuit RSI 2.6)

The Course will be signalled by a Red or a Green Flag displayed from the SSCBC Eastern Mast 1 hour before the race.

Boats are required to cross a line perpendicular (90 degrees) to each Sorrento Channel mark. The course may be shortened at any of these lines in accordance with RRS 32.2 (b)

### TIME LIMIT

The Finish Window in SI 20.2 is changed to a time limit of 5 hours.

### SAFETY NOTES

Note that in the event of an ambulance being required for an injury, we may meet the ambulance at the Rye Boat Ramp or Portsea Pier instead of the Club Jetty. – It depends on the incident, location and conditions.

Please monitor VHF 73 throughout the race to provide mutual safety support to each other.
