#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing including the Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2.
- 1.2. Appendix S - Standard Sailing Instructions and Appendix T – Arbitration will apply
- 1.3. Add to Outside Help RRS 41: (e) A boat may receive any help from a She Sails coach.

#### 2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. Eligible classes 420, 29er, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Sabre, Optimist, Minnow and Pacers (6 club pacers are available) until that class' quota is filled.
- 3.2. Each class has a minimum and maximum allocation.  
Classes that do not meet the minimum entries will have their allocation moved to another class and competitors will be refunded their entry.
- 3.3. Competitors must be female.
- 3.4. Entry is via <https://sscbc.com.au/SheSails>
- 3.5. Late entry fee and cancelling of classes not meeting minimum numbers will apply from **Thur 28/2/19**
- 3.6. The closing date for entries is **Thur 28/2/19**, 8pm.

#### 4. FEES

- 4.1. The Entry fee for single-handed boats is \$125.00 and \$250 for double-handed.
- 4.2. **1 day Entry fee for single-handed boats is \$65.00 and \$125 for double-handed.**
- 4.3. Entries received after **8pm, Thur 28/2/19** will be charged an extra \$15 per competitor
- 4.4. An additional fee of \$40 for Pacer supply if using an SSCBC Pacer.

#### 5. FORMAT

Dinghies will compete in short 20-25 minute races.

#### 6. PACERS

6 boats will be supplied for the racing, if we get more than 6 crews, we will do boat swaps onto the coach boat and this will be valuable learning as well – see directly what the coach sees. BYO Pacer is also encouraged.

#### 7. SCORING

Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score once 3 races are completed and excluding her worst 2 scores once 7 races have been completed. One race is required to constitute a series.
