

SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

SORRENTO 2020 RSX Club Championship



1. REGATTA OFFICE & FLAGPOLE LOCATION

Regatta Office – Training Centre N/E corner of Club. The Flagpole is N/E of this.

2. RULES

- 2.1. Add to RRS 41: (e) help to recover from the water and return on board a crew member, provided the return on board is at the approximate location of the recovery.
- 2.2. When AP is displayed ashore, RRS S4.2 is changed to “not less than 10 minutes”
- 2.3. RRS S3.1 is deleted, any change to the sailing instructions will be posted 30 minutes before the first scheduled race it effects or before AP/H ashore is removed.
- 2.4. The Post-Race Penalty in RRS T1(b) is changed to 25% of the difference between a boat’s score and RET score.

3. SIGN ON – SIGN OFF

Boats shall sign on before going afloat and sign off at the first reasonable opportunity upon returning ashore [DP]

4. WARNING SIGNALS

5. CLASS FLAGS

Men Numeral 1
Women Numeral 2

6. THE FINISH

RRS S11 is changed to a blue flag.

7. MARKS

Start Pin Orange Inflatable or RCV
1,2,3p/s 4p/s Inflatable coach marks
Finish Pin Blue Flag

8. TIME LIMITS:

Race Time limit 30min
Finishing Window 5min
Boats not finishing within the Finishing Window may be allocated a score [DP] Changes RRS 35, A4, A5 and S12.3

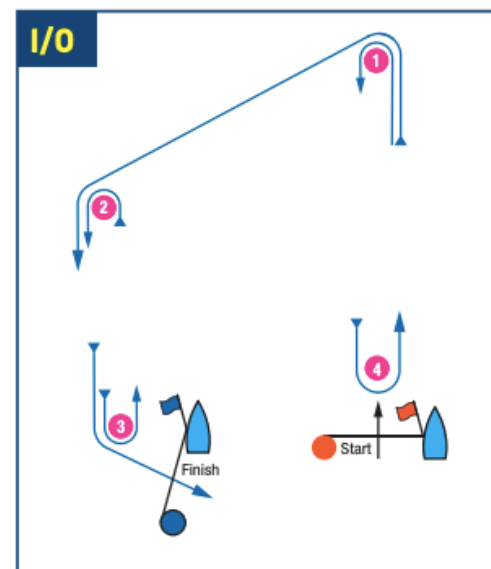
9. PROTEST AND REDRESS TIME LIMITS

Unless extended, for each division, the protest time limit and redress time limit is 20 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day. “or two hours after the incident, whichever is later” is deleted from rule 62.2” This changes RRS S13.2.

10. PENALTIES

RRS Appendix T applies; the Post Race Penalty T1 (b) is changed to increase a boat’s score by 25% of the difference between her race score and the score for retirement.

11. COURSES



If a matching mark is laid in the vicinity of mark 3 or 4, then they become a gate.

Women I2

I2 Start – 1-4 – 1-2-3 – Finish

Men O2

O2 Start – 1-2-3 – 2-3 – Finish

12. SUPPORT PERSONS [DP]

Can enter the course sensibly
Will be helping with racing
Shall wear PFDs at all times afloat.
Shall not do dumb or careless things

For this SSI, RRS 63 is changed so that a [DP] may be applied without a hearing and RRS 64.4 is deleted.
