#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 Off the Beach Boats.
- 1.2. Appendix S: Standard Sailing Instruction and Appendix T; Arbitration will apply
- 1.3. Changes to rules that will be detailed in full in the sailing instructions include:

# 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. Boats may be entered by members of their class Association by agreeing to the <u>conditions of entry</u>, paying the entry fee and completing the entry form, which contains other conditions and an alert about the risks of sailing which the person entering the boat, must agree to <u>ENTER HERE</u>

# 3. FEES

- 3.1. The Flying Dutchman entry fee is \$150 per boat entered by Sunday 28/2/2021
- 3.2. The entry fee is \$100 per boat entered by Sunday 28/2/2021
- 3.3. An additional \$50 late entry fee will apply to each boat entered after Sunday 28/2/2021
- 3.4. Entry closes at 5 pm Thursday 11/2/2021

# 4. SCHEDULE and FORMAT

- 4.1. Racing will be conducted in sessions, 3-4 shorter races per day are planned depending upon weather conditions and forecast.
- 4.2. Presentations will be held each day after racing.

# 9. SCORING

# 9.1. Symmetrical Spinnaker Challenge

Boats will be scored using YV Handicaps.

To be a scored in a Class Team a class must have at least 3 entries.

Class Team scores will be the combined series scores equal to the number of boats in the smallest class less

- 9.2. Each class will also be scored as a separate class and series excluding a boat's worst score once 4 races are completed.
- 9.3. An accessible sub division will also be scored where boats get an extra drop each day so they can go in after three races if that suits them.
- 9.4. 3 races must be completed to constitute a series.

## 10. SUPPORTERS

10.1. Supporters who are not SSCBC members will be granted honorary membership on regatta days and are required to abide by the Rules and Codes of SSCBC and Australian Sailing and comply with any reasonable request from the Race Committee, including maintaining separation from boats racing and supporting rescues of other boats where required if afloat.
