Clubhouse Redevelopment





Dear Members,

This week, the SSCBC General Committee resolved to sign the building contract for the Clubhouse redevelopment with Lloyd Group (<u>https://lloydgroup.com.au/</u>). This is an incredibly exciting milestone for the Club and follows an extensive process to design a facility that will meet the needs of our Members now and in the future.

Construction is scheduled to commence from 14 February 2022, with works scheduled for completion in November 2022.

The development funding is underpinned by existing cash reserves and a debt facility with National Australia Bank. Opportunities will also be presented to Members to participate in funding through investing in SSCBC issued bonds which will significantly benefit the Club by lowering borrowing costs and increasing flexibility. Tax deductible donations and pledges will also be encouraged. As previously indicated, a building levy will be applied to existing and new Members' subscriptions from 1 July 2022 as is typical in projects of this nature in club environments.

Information covering all aspects of the redevelopment including operational, budgetary, financing and Member contributions will be provided via e-Tidings and the Clubhouse Redevelopment section of our website. We will also be holding Member briefings via Zoom, the first of which will be held on Tuesday 8 February at 6:30pm. See below.

I am pleased that we will be able to offer a full schedule of sailing activities throughout the redevelopment with a sailing 'hub' to be set up in a marquee on Lavender Hill. Whilst our existing Clubhouse will no longer be available for use once the redevelopment commences, a temporary clubhouse, complete with heating, an inside dining area and a deck, will be set up on the Eastern Lawn. This will provide a place for the SSCBC community meet and socialise during sailing activities, and also allow a program of feature events including paella and BBQ nights. We recognise that the closure and construction work impacting 2022 represents another chapter of interruption following the last two years. Notwithstanding, we are confident that by continuing a full program of sailing and providing a food & beverage offering through the temporary Clubhouse, the impact will be limited. Most importantly, as we look forward to the end of 2022, the redevelopment will provide world class facilities to our Members across our sailing, hospitality and event spaces, and will continue our proud history of providing sailing opportunities to all, from junior dinghy sailors to our incredible fleet of Couta Boats.

As always, the General Committee thanks the Members for their continued support as we move to this next exciting phase of the project. We look forward to providing further details very soon, and keeping you informed every step of the way.

Lavender Hill Sailors' Drinks




