SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



1. CHANGES TO RULES

- RRS S3 is replaced with. Amendments to the SI made ashore will be posted at least 1 hour before the start of any race affected or before AP/H is removed. Amendments made afloat will be signalled by the display of flag L with 1 sound signal. The Race Committee may communicate these either verbally or in writing.
- AP over a numeral pennant 1-9 is deleted from Race Signals.
- P2.1 is changed so that it applies to all penalties. P2.2 and P2.3 are deleted.

2. SIGN ON – SIGN OFF

Boats shall sign on before going afloat and sign off at the first reasonable opportunity upon returning ashore (at Regatta Office) [DP]




3. THE START – Changes to RRS 26

The start is changed to a 3-minute sequence as described in NOR 9

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

When the AP flag is displayed ashore, 60 mins is replaced with 30 mins. This changes RRS S4.2.
