The Organising Authority is Sorrento Sailing Couta Boat Club

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including AS Special Regulations Pt. 2
- 1.2. Appendices WF: Wingfoiling Racing Rules will apply and T: Arbitration will apply as modified.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Eligible Equipment: Wing Foil Boards; Wind Wings equal to or less than 6m²; Foils open (Competitors are limited to 2 foil combinations at registration).
- 2.2. All Competitors that are not otherwise a member of a Club affiliated with Australian Sailing (AS) will be provided with an AS Sail Pass membership that includes Personal Accident Insurance.
- 2.3. The Official Notice Board (Online) <http://www.sscbc.com.au/wing> has links to the entry form, other conditions and an alert about the risks of sailing, which the person entering the boat must agree to.
- 2.4. Entries Close Friday 17:00 2nd of December 2022

3. FEES

- 3.1. The fee of \$65 and includes after race feed (light meal)
- 3.2. Late entries after 20 November welcomed with additional \$20 fee.

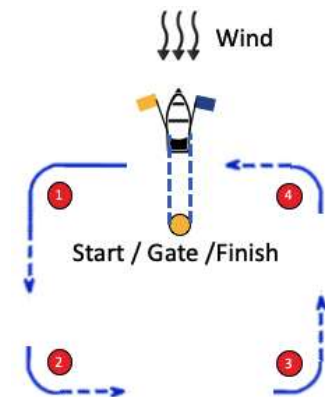
4. FORMAT

- 4.1. Racing will be run in sessions, optimised daily to the weather forecast
Depending upon entries, racing may be conducted as a single fleet, divisions or in groups with a qualifying series and final series.

5. SCHEDULE –

The schedule will be updated to optimise the use of available weather. An initial update to the schedule will be posted at least 2 days in advance of the first day.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1. Sailing Instructions will be provided at Registration and available on line prior to registration.
- 6.2. The sailing instructions will mandate the use of helmets and life vests. These will be made available by the OA.

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the OA.

- 12.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million per incident or the equivalent.
