



**CALL FOR NOMINATIONS &
PRELIMINARY NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING**

In accordance with the Rules of the Club, the Committee shall, prior to each Annual General Meeting, give notice to members calling for nomination of candidates for election as Officers or as Ordinary Members of the Committee. The Annual General Meeting will be held at the Clubhouse on Sunday 13th October 2024 at 1000 hrs.

Nomination of Members of the Committee

a) To elect Officers as follows:

- Commodore **Georgie Silverwood** is retiring under Rule 54. A nomination form has been received from **Scott Llewelyn**.
- Vice Commodore **Scott Llewelyn** is retiring under Rule 54. A nomination form has been received from **Howard Critchley**.
- Rear Commodore **Mark Klemens** is retiring under Rule 54. A nomination form has been received from **Richard Martin**.
- Treasurer **Andrew Scott** is retiring under Rule 54 and wishes to stand for re-election.
- Secretary **Tim Collett** is retiring under Rule 54 and wishes to stand for re-election.

b) To elect Committee persons as follows:

The Committee shall consist of at least three but not more than five Ordinary Members of the Committee.

The following Ordinary Committee Members retire by rotation under Rule 52 (1) and wish to stand for re-election:

The following Ordinary Committee Member is continuing and does not need to stand for re-election:

A nomination of a candidate for election as a member of the Committee must be:

- (a) in writing and on the form available from the office
- (b) signed by the applicant, a proposer, a seconder and 4 referees who have each been members of the Club for at least 3 years and are not a relative of the candidate; and
- (c) delivered to the Secretary at least 28 days prior to the Annual General Meeting

A nomination of a candidate for election under this rule is invalid if that candidate has already been nominated for another position.

Under Rule 46 (2) not less than 5 members of the Committee must be owners of a Couta Boat.
