
#### **Safety Boats**

- Monitor your whole fleet
- Brevity "humour via tone or 1 additional word"
- Advise as changing areas Count all your boats ashore
- Notify the Tower if a boat leaves the racing areas and returns to shore

#### **AT ALL TIMES**

- Radio On active listening
- All capsizes Determine if normal or hard Watch heads come up and OK
- Call for support when you have no capacity to handle the next problem.

Outside help rule changed – No penalty for getting help in danger – can keep racing.
