Team Sorrento

Pathways: The levels within Team Sorrento are Junior, Next Gen and Adult.



When junior sailors graduate from the Stripy Squad level 3, we encourage them to join Team Sorrento. The Junior level consists of Green Fleet, Intermediate Fleet and Open Fleet and are sailed in a private Opti.

The pathways in the Next Gen level for teenagers and young adults include the Youth Transition Squad (delivered on Quests), Team and Match Racing, Powerboating, Foiling and instructing/coaching.

The Adult pathway includes Learn to Sail lessons, Powerboating and Coaching.

Private Lessons: There is also the option of private lessons for each group.

Dinghy Rental: Once sailors are confident enough, they can contact us and rent one of our Club boats.
