2. Annual Reports of the Committee

2.1 Commodore's Report

Georgie Silverwood (GS) delivered the Commodore's Report. The full report is available on the club website. Major points:

- Treasurer will report a trading surplus for the year and our plans to manage debt from the rebuilding program
- Membership numbers remain stable

2.2 General Manager's Report

2.4 Treasurer's Report

- Club recorded strong financial performance with a net profit, EBITDA, net Assets and cash at bank all ahead of budget
- The clubhouse development debt at 30 June 2024 was \$3.98m with the development complete. The debt is set to be repaid over 6.5 years.
- The club continues to maintain strong operational, financial and budgetary controls. A new finance sub-committee has been formed.

Questions - Sue Cockman asked why the club spent money on an interior designer when the club was in debt. Rollo Wright responded it was a relatively small investment against the cost of redevelopment and was focused on the display of heritage items.
